At the end of 2015 Helen was accepted as an Exhibiting Member of the Ku-ring-gai Art Society Inc and continues to exhibit with the Central Coast Watercolour Society, 5 Lands, Killcare annual art show and other exhibitions.

Helen has been hung twice in Gosford Art Show, 2016 with Case for Books and 2017 with Venice in Indigo.

Also in 2017 Guest Artist at Easter Exhibition for CCWCS and continues to exhibit at the Ku-ring-Gai Art Exhibitions 3 times a year.

Also completed 12 Dog portrait commissions this year and involved in open studios with 5 Lands Art Trail and 3 exhibitions related to this community organisation.
