Norma completed a Fine arts degree in 2000 followed by a one year advanced painting course and a one year printmaking course both at Hornsby college of TAFE.

Oils, acrylics and mixed media have each been experimented with.

Attending summer school workshops at the National Art School Darlinghurst, exploring a variety of techniques and working with other artists has added to her experience.

The environment is the subject of her artworks, painting from memories of travels throughout Australia. Large paintings of flowers with the Gynea lily and Lotus are a recurring theme.



Norma has recently begun using fabrics she has dyed with natural vegetation and then stitched them together with silk thread to create soft sculptures of landforms.

Seedpods and leaves gathered from various locations have also been worked into these collages. All found objects are seen with the idea of including them in a work yet to be created.
